Jang-hyeon Yoon, a pianist, graduated from Yewon School, completed the preparatory program at the Korea National Institute for the Gifted in Arts. After entering Seoul Arts High School as an outstanding performer, he soon chose home-schooling. He made his debut as a soloist at the Kumho Prodigy Concert at the age of 15, played at the Seoul Arts Center Music Gifted Concert, in the Korea Liszt Competition Gala Concert, at the Young Musicians Festival, and at the Junior Mozart Joint Concert. He was selected as the OnDream Art and Culture Talent Scholarship student at Hyundai Motor Company's Chung Mong-Koo Foundation and participated in regular performances of the OnDream Ensemble.

Starting with the 1st prize in the Yewon Music Competition in 2014, he won the Eumyeon Competition, Korea Brahms Competition, Korea Liszt Competition, Suri Music Concours, Chung-Ang University Competition, and Yejurang Music Competition. He also won the Korea Steinway Competition, Music Chunchu Competition, Korea Beethoven Competition, Kookmin daily & Hansei University Music Competition, and Korea Chopin Competition. He participated in the Ishikawa Music Academy, OPF Piano Academy, and received masterpieces from Soo-Jung Shin, Kyung-Sook Lee, Jan Jiracek von Arnim, Phillip Kawin, Enrico Pace, Lev Natochenny, Fumiko Eguchi, and Piotr Paleczny.

He currently studies with pianist Choog-Mo Kang and will enter Seoul National University in this March.
