Yunsun Shin is attending her third year at the Yewon School, the top art middle school in Korea, from which she will graduate in February of 2020. Majoring in Piano, she has also been studying with Ms. Jungwon Suh at the private Trinity School of Music since 2015. Prior to attending Yewon School, she was a student at Seoul Art Center Academy for Gifted in Music.

Known for passion in music and hard work ethic, Yunsun has won numerous awards and competitions. She was awarded First Place at the Kirov International Junior E-Piano Competition, Grand Prize at the 2020 Steinway Competition, Korea, and Third Place in the International Chopin Piano Competition in Yokohama, Japan. She has also had opportunities to perform and participate in numerous concerts including the Euro Music Festival's Opening Concert, the On Dream Ensemble Concert sponsored by Chung Mong-Koo Foundation (Hyundai

Motor Company), Steinway Competition Winner's Recital, and performing as a soloist with the Prime Philharmonic Orchestra and the Seoul Orchestra.
